Dear Donors,

We would like to thank you for taking the monumental step to contribute to the IIT (BHU) Foundation for the Access Fund. Your generous donation supported the Foundation's Access Fund, which has enabled full ride scholarships for 80 students in the 2025-2026 academic session, and 36 students in the 2024-2025 session to attend IIT (BHU), a premier Institute in India. In addition, there were 21 students in the 2021-2022 session, 22 students in the 2022-2023 session, and 34 students in the 2023-2024 that received full ride scholarships, for a total of 193 scholarship recipients as of today. **Your contribution has made the direct impact of broadening access to education and preparing future leaders in critical areas of technology.**

This is our fifth year of scholarships and please allow us to briefly explain the overall process. The application process for the scholarship began with an online application, made available on the Foundation website for several weeks between October 2025 and December 2025. The Foundation received 186 completed applications. Each application was reviewed against criteria recommended by the Scholarship Committee and approved by the Board of the Foundation. The criteria were strictly means-based, and involved annual family income levels, as applicable tuition fees varied accordingly (see below).

All qualified applications were considered until the target number of recipients was achieved. The selected awardees were notified via email and confirmed their acceptance in February 2026. Recognizing that these are four-year commitments, as opposed to one year, the Foundation maintained its fiduciary responsibility to ensure that investment returns would be sufficient to support these students for four years.

The Committee, though quite pleased about the 80 awardees, does believe that it is important to share that this does not represent the pool of all qualified applicants. The **awards for 2025 represent 43% of applications**, leaving a large pool of applicants who we could not assist this year. **31% of recipients are women** (a 2 ppts increase from 2024), and all female applicants were awarded a scholarship this year with family income 5Lakhs or less. Even with this increase in women recipients, we still believe that it is important to encourage more women in STEM, especially those who are economically disadvantaged.

Many of us know firsthand the transformative power of a world-class education. Accordingly, we hope that through the continued support of generous benefactors such as yourselves, the Foundation will be able to raise additional funds to grow the Access Fund further.

We sincerely look forward to that day!
